## **Make Smoking History - From Every Quitter**

When we asked smokers what was the main reason their quit attempts had failed, the most common answer by far was friends and family smoking around them.

Last month Make Smoking History (MSH) launched the brand new WA-made campaign 'From Every Quitter'. The campaign features a diverse group of twelve Western Australians who have recently quit smoking or are currently attempting to quit. In the television advertisement each person delivers an authentic heartfelt plea directly to camera, asking smokers, "If you can't quit with me, don't smoke around me."

'Seeing other people smoke' was uncovered as a key trigger to light up by smokers involved in focus group research that was commissioned by Make Smoking History in November 2015. The same study, found that having loved ones who smoke was the number one barrier to quitting smoking for both males and females. This campaign aims to help people on their quitting journey by rallying the support of their friends and family, especially those who continue to smoke. It will run throughout WA until Saturday 6 May 2017.

Research shows that 2 out of 3 long term smokers will die from their cigarette addiction, ie of the 257,000 adults in WA who smoke, 171,000 will die from their smoking habit; every day approximately 50 people are

admitted into hospital due to tobacco smoking and 1,600 (4 people per day) die from tobacco use every year in WA alone.

Now is as good a day as any to quit. There is help out there. Talk to your GP or call Quitline on 13 78 48, visit makesmokinghistory.org.au for information and resources or contact the Wheatbelt Cancer Council WA office or your closest Public Health Unit for any local quit smoking courses." 

## Mosquito-Borne Disease Risk Increase Across WA

Media Release Shire of Lake Grace

There has been increased publicity recently in regard to mosquito-borne diseases due to flooding throughout Western Australia.

People living or travelling throughout Western Australia do not need to change their travel plans, but should take extra precautions to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes, including:

- avoiding outdoor exposure particularly around dawn and dusk (and the first few hours after dark)
- wearing protective (long, loose-fitting, light coloured) clothing when outdoors
- applying a personal repellent containing 20 per cent diethyltoluamide (DEET) or picaridin to exposed skin or clothing. The most effective and long-lasting formulations are lotions or gels. Natural or organic repellents may not be as effective as DEET or picaridin, or may need to be reapplied more frequently
- wearing head nets if outdoors
- ensuring insect screens are installed and in good condition – the use of bed nets when sleeping will offer further protection
- using mosquito nets or mosquito-proof tents

when camping or sleeping outdoors
 ensuring infants and children are adequately protected against biting insects, preferably with suitable clothing, bed nets or other forms of insect screening.

The recent rainfall is also a timely reminder for residents to minimise mosquito breeding around the home by taking some simple steps to remove or modify breeding sites such as:



## CEO's Corner

#### Flooding Event - February 2017

The Main Roads WA approved independent engineer appointed to assess the infrastructure damage has completed the physical assessment and will now prepare a report and costing to be presented to MRWA. Until this assessment is finalised we are not able to access any WANDRRA funding.

#### **WANDRRA** Funding

In response to the widespread flood damage across much of Western Australia in February, a workshop was held to develop a revised model to enable Local Governments to claim reimbursement of cost incurred in restoring public assets damaged in declared natural disasters through the WA Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (WANDRRA).

Currently, Local Governments can only recover costs incurred by contractors or in overtime payments to staff, when reinstating public assets damaged or destroyed in natural disasters.

The workshop was attended by representatives of Main Roads, Local Government, WALGA, Department of Premier and Cabinet and the Office of Emergency Management (OEM).

The delegates agreed that the current Federal Government proposal to allow claims for Local Government day labour, but excluding plant and

consumables, would result in substantial under recovery for Local Governments and would not provide a feasible alternative to the current methodology of contracting out all the works.

It was agreed to develop an approach based on an "Upfront Model" proposed by the Federal Government for potential implementation next year with the following framework:

- Local Governments will prepare an upfront scope of works and cost estimate
- Main Roads will approve the scope of works and estimate and authorise the works to proceed
- Local Governments will have the flexibility to execute the work using any method that they consider the most practical and cost effective
- Local Government will claim full reimbursement based on certificates of work completed. This could be monthly or on completion
- there will be a mechanism to accommodate variations for latent defects and other unforeseen issues; and
- there will be an opportunity to claim a percentage of the estimated cost as an upfront payment.

The OEM has compiled a discussion paper and ministerial briefing seeking an exemption from the Federal Government in order to trial this model for restoration work needed following the recent disaster event.

If the reformed model is not accepted, then the OEM has further asked for an alternative exemption where the use of own sourced labour including plant and consumables be accepted.

Until any decision is made in relation to WANDRRA funding any works the Shire undertakes using our own staff will not be considered for reimbursement. Given this we are endeavouring to follow the current processes in place to ensure we are eligible for reimbursement on all repair work undertaken.

#### **Mosquito Fogging**

We are currently fogging weekly in the Lake Grace and Newdegate townsites. Due to the recent floods the Shire is investigating further options to reduce the mosquito infestation around all townsites, however, it is equally important that the community itself implements some of the simple steps recommended.

To help control the mosquito breeding cycle please be vigilant and check your property for any stagnant water (e.g. in pot plants) and reduce overgrown vegetation.

#### **Building & Maintenance Team**

The Building Maintenance Team has been assisting with works at the Lake Grace Independent Living Units (ILUs) by fitting doors and windows to Unit 3 and completing timber works on Unit 3 walls.

Progress on the ILU's can now easily be seen with the completion of roof installations. The coming weeks will see the external cladding go up, putting the units into lockup which will enable internal fitout. Electrical works are progressing with fitout of internal wiring and power point locations being fixed.

#### **Road Works**

Our Construction Team finished Morton Road and returned to Holt Rock South Road to trim the road ready for bitumen sealing work which was carried out over the weekend. They are now working on Hatters Hill Road and will be staying out at Lake King.

Newdegate and Lake King grading contractors are busy grading flood damaged roads. The Lake Grace Maintenance Grader is grading school bus routes damaged by flooding.

## **Bushfire Bulletin**



## What will you do if you encounter a bushfire while travelling or staying near bushland?

In Western Australia, bushfires can start suddenly without warning throughout the year. People have been killed or seriously injured during bushfires. If you are travelling or staying near bushland, fire is a real risk to you. Be aware of your surroundings and carry a printed map of the areas you are visiting. Pack an emergency kit to take with you including important items such as woollen blankets, drinking water and protective clothing.

#### If there is a lot of smoke

- Slow down as there could be people, vehicles and livestock on the road.
- Turn your car headlights and hazard lights on.
- Close the windows and outside vents.
- If you can't see clearly, pull over and wait until the smoke clears.

#### If you become trapped by a fire

- Park the vehicle off the roadway where there is little vegetation, with the vehicle facing towards the oncoming fire front.
- Turn the engine off.
- Close the car doors, windows and outside vents.
- Call 000
- Stay as close to the floor as possible and cover your mouth with a damp cloth to avoid inhalation of smoke. If smoke enters the vehicle, toxic fumes are released from the interior of the vehicle.
- Stay covered in woollen blankets, continue to drink water and wait for assistance.

 Stay in the car until the fire front has passed and do not open windows or doors.

Once the front has passed and the temperature has dropped, cautiously exit the vehicle. Internal parts may still be extremely hot.

During an emergency, one of the best things you can do for your safety is keep informed about where the danger is, what is happening and what to do.

DFES recommends that people use a range of sources of information about an emergency.

This includes:

- using the DFES website to access warnings
- staying in touch with neighbours, family and friends
- being alert and aware of your surroundings
- tuning in to ABC local radio
- listening to <u>6PR</u> if you are in the Perth metropolitan area

If someone you know alerts you to a possible emergency, or if you can see or smell something that might be dangerous, that's your warning.

Never rely on any one source and remember, you know best what is happening in your immediate surroundings.

If you believe you may be in danger, act immediately for your own safety. In a life threatening emergency call triple zero (000).

## **Apprentice to Subbie – Goods and Services Tax**

If you are planning to set yourself up as a self-employed contractor or subcontractor, you will need to consider the question of whether or not you register for the Goods and Services Tax (GST).

If you have started a new business and expect it to reach or exceed the GST turnover threshold in your first year of operation, you should register for GST straight away. For most business types including subbies and self-employed tradespeople, the GST turnover threshold is a gross income minus GST of \$75 000 per year. You also need to register if you want to claim fuel tax credits for your business.

#### Registering for GST

You can register for GST when you first register your business or at any later time and you will need an Australian Business Number to do so. Check out our previous articles in this series for more info on getting an ABN.

For all businesses registered for GST, the goods and services you sell in Australia are taxable (unless they are GST-free or input taxed) and you will need to complete regular Business Activity Statements (BAS) which are lodged with the Australian Tax Office (ATO), usually quarterly.

#### Reaching the Threshold

If you're not registered for GST, or don't expect to reach the threshold, you still need to check on a monthly basis to see whether you've reached the threshold, or are likely to exceed it. If your turnover does exceed the threshold, you must register within 21 days of reaching it. If you don't register for GST and are required to do so, you may have to pay GST on the sales you have made since the date you became required to register. This could happen even if you did not include GST in the price of those sales. You may also have to pay penalties and interest.

If your business is not required to be registered for GST and you have chosen not to register you should not collect GST on your sales or claim GST credits on your purchases. You can however claim the full cost of your business purchases (including any GST) as a tax deduction on your income tax return.

#### **Seeking Professional Advice**

We've only touched on the key issues for the question 'do I or don't I' when it comes to registering for GST and this information should be treated as a guide only as individual circumstances can vary. As always with tax or financial matters, getting expert advice is a very good idea.

#### Pre seeding 2017

Seeding is only just around the corner, especially after all the Summer rains, so its timely to review our electrical pre season check list.

<u>Two-ways</u> - check all your two ways (UHF + VHF) are in good working order, UHF should be able to transmit up to 20 kilometres with a good aerial, VHF further. If the sets are faulty, bring them into store so we can have them repaired before the rush. We also have GME electraphone, UNIDEN and ICOM two ways in stock. We can arrange VHF sets in most common brands.

## Mosquito-Borne Disease Risk Increase Across WA

(cont)

- empty out or dispose containers or rubbish which may hold water
- stock ornamental ponds with fish and keeping vegetation away from the water's edge
- keep swimming pools well chlorinated, filtered and free of dead leaves
- fill or drain depressions in the ground that hold water
- fit mosquito proof covers to vent pipes on septic tank systems, sealing all gaps around the lid and ensure leach drains are completely covered
- screen rainwater tanks with insect proof mesh, including inlet, overflow and inspection ports
- clean out roof gutters to prevent water pooling
- empty pot plant drip trays once a week or fill them with sand
- empty, clean and refill animal and pet drinking water bowls once a week.

The Shire is currently undertaking weekly routine fogging in Lake Grace and Newdegate townsites. 
